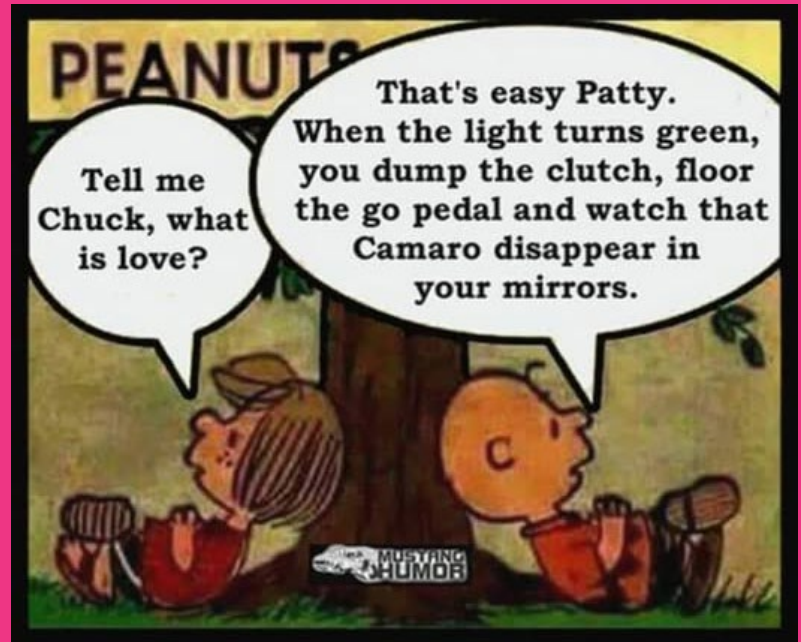

A big thank you again to Dana Pruchno, Treehouse's Drives and Community Engagement Manager, for attending our January meeting. Dana gave an insightful presentation on the opportunity gap that exists for youth in foster care and Treehouse's mission to help close that gap in our state. Washington youth in foster care have higher rates of experiencing homelessness by age 17, having a child by the age of 21, being arrested or jailed with one year of aging out of foster care, and a lower rate of success when it comes to post-high school education. Treehouse works with youth to ensure their social, developmental, and material needs are met so they have a greater chance of success in adulthood.

## New Requirements for Collector Vehicle and Horseless Carriage Plates

A recent law change updates the requirements for two types of uncommon license plates.

Effective Jan. 15, 2026, anyone applying for a collector vehicle or horseless carriage plate must meet new standards.

To get a new collector plate, you must provide:

- Proof of vehicle ownership (unless the vehicle is already in our records).
- A valid registration for a second vehicle used for daily driving, commuting, or business purposes.
- Proof of vehicle insurance.

Vehicles with restored plates are also subject to the second (daily) vehicle and insurance requirements.

If you already have a vehicle registered with a collector plate, documentation is needed only if we request it.

What does this mean for you?

Say you want to register your dream '68 Shelby as a collector vehicle. You'll need a valid registration for a different, daily driver, as well as proof of vehicle insurance. If you registered your '81 DeLorean as a collector vehicle prior to the law change, you'll only need to carry proof of insurance when driving.

The legal definition of a horseless carriage plate also has changed. To be eligible for this rare plate, a vehicle must be manufactured or built before Jan. 1, 1916.

We will mail a courtesy notice about these changes to all current collector vehicle and horseless carriage owners. No need to reply to the letter.

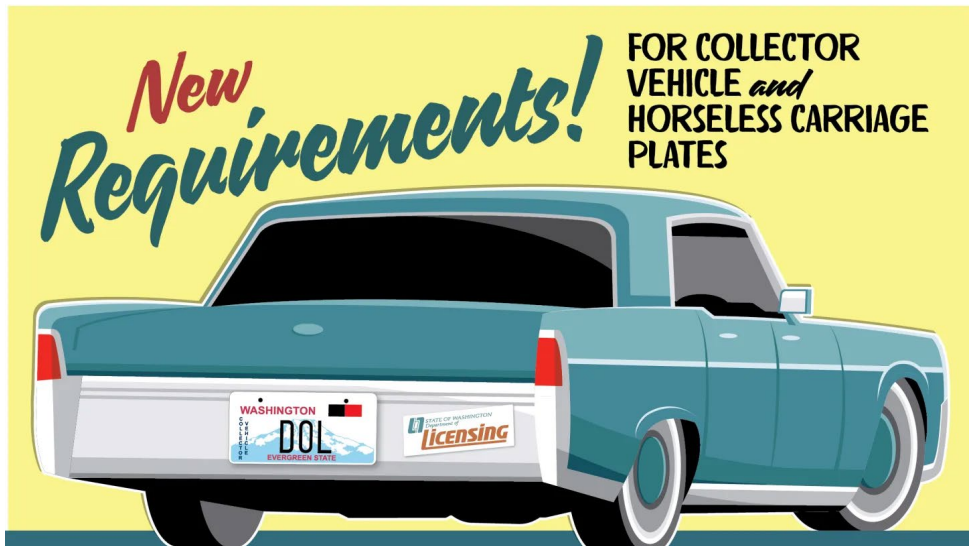
If you no longer own a collector vehicle in our records, be sure to complete a Report of Sale. This protects you from liability if a vehicle is not transferred out of your name.

If we ask for information regarding a collector plate in your possession, response is required within 45 days. If we don't hear from you, any such plates will be canceled.

To ensure you receive any communications from us, keep your address updated in License Express.

These changes in requirements, a result of Substitute Senate Bill 5127, are meant to improve compliance and enhance public safety. Learn more about the relevant laws:

- Horseless carriage license plates: RCW 46.18.255
- Vehicle insurance requirements: RCW 46.29.090
- Mandatory liability insurance: RCW 46.30.020

## 47th International Mustang Meet September 3rd - 7th, 2026 in Richmond BC Hosted by the Greater Vancouver Mustang Association

If you've ever considered attending the annual International Mustang Meet, IMM 47 will be right in our own backyard in Richmond BC (near Vancouver) next Labor Day Weekend Sept. 3-7, 2026). Several PCMC Members have attended IMM's in the past, to rave reviews. We have several club members who already have their cars registered and hotel booked for IMM 47. Details on a club caravan will be announced closer to the date next September.

A Little History about the International Mustang Meet (thank you to Linda Hallberg) - The International Mustang Meet began in 1980 when two Mustangers, one American and one Canadian, met at a World of Wheels car show while each was showing a Mustang Convertible. They became best friends and thought it would be a great idea that an International Mustang Meet be held each year. They would start in Lethbridge, Alberta, Canada and then swap between the US and Canada each year. During that first year, there were three clubs and 75 cars, and the Labor Day weekend was chosen to allow for travel to the meet each year.

Today, the event has become more than a car show. There are 300-500 vehicles each year that gather on Labor Day weekend, and is a social event reuniting friendships made through the years. Friday night begins with a Welcome Party; Saturday is the show day followed by a BBQ in the evening. On Sunday there could be a special drive, potential Auto Cross or Poker Run, and ends with an Awards Banquet. Finally, we gather for breakfast on Monday morning and say goodbye until next year.
